Enclosed is the IEPA letter (Reference 1) stating that no NPDES permit modification is required for NPDES Permit Number IL0026123. IEPA reviewed Fermilab's letter and supporting documents (Reference 2) and approved our request to 1) substitute one biocide for another as part of the non-contact cooling water operations performed at the Central Utilities Building and 2) to install a chemical treatment system at the Industrial Building 1 non-contact cooling water system. Fermilab's proposed usage of Spectrus Oxide 109 (replaces Spectrus Oxide 909), Spectrus NX112, sodium hypochlorite, and Spectrus DT1404 can start immediately.

The Agency received your letter and supporting documents dated June 11, 2010. We have reviewed the submittal and find that an NPDES permit modification is not required under Illinois Pollution Control Board Chapter 1: Subtitle C Regulations, Sub-part A for the facilities proposed.
