If you do not like the feature Snap from Windows 7 here is a way to turn it off.

1. Go to your Control Panel.
2. Click on Ease of Access Center.
3. Click on Change how your mouse works.
4. Check the box that says Prevent windows from being automatically arranged when moved to the edge of the screen.
5. Click Ok.
