SUBJECT: CULTURAL RESOURCE REPORTS FOR FERMI NATIONAL ACCELERATOR LABORATORY (FERMILAB), BATAVIA, ILLINOIS

- Reference: 1. *Recordation of Historic Farmstead 11-Du-524 in Winfield Township, DuPage County Illinois on Fermi National Accelerator Laboratory Property*, November 29, 2012, copy enclosed.
2. *Site Correction Form for Historic Farmstead 11-Du-219 in Winfield Township, DuPage County Illinois on Fermi National Accelerator Laboratory Property*, November 29, 2012, copy enclosed.

In compliance with the National Historic Preservation Act (NHPA), and the Department of Energy (DOE) Order 141.1, the *Recordation of Historic Farmstead 11-Du-524 in Winfield Township* was developed by Midwest Archaeological Research Services, Inc., to record the discovery of a limestone-lined well within an agricultural field in the vicinity of historic farmstead 11-Du-524 located on Fermilab property. The report also describes the inadvertent razing of a barn (Baumann Barn; Farm Site 12) which was in the vicinity of historic farmstead 11-Du-524 due to structural instability without recording as an archaeological site. In response to this occurrence, Fermilab is surveying all remaining farmsteads that have not previously been recorded and has informed personnel that cultural resource specialists need to be contacted prior to razing "historic structures" per the NHPA.

Also, in compliance with the NHPA, and DOE Order 141.1, the *Site Correction Form for Recordation of Historic Farmstead 11-Du-219 in Winfield Township* was developed by Midwest Archaeological Research Services, Inc., to correct this historic farmsteads record. The record was corrected by increasing the site dimensions to include the existing barn and a well inadvertently found by a Fermilab maintenance crew during landscape work.
