Rx eyewear - What kind of prescription do I need for corrective lenses?	You must have a prescription for corrective lenses which is not more than 12 months old . Rx eyewear - How do I pay for eyewear upgrades?	If you choose a frame style which has an additional charge, you will have to pay that amount prior to your order being placed.
