Non-employee Agent authorized to perform control activities:

Conditions:

1. Permittee is authorized to destroy Canada goose nests and eggs only on property under the jurisdiction of the agency. No control activities may be conducted on Federal and/or State land without written permission from the agency with jurisdiction.
2. Canada goose egg destruction will be carried out by Addling, Oiling, Puncturing or Freezing. No Poison of any kind will be used.
3. Canada goose eggs must be disposed of by burial or incineration in an incinerator that is in compliance with the Illinois Environmental Protection Act. No parts of the animals may be used, sold, or utilized in any manner.
4. No other wildlife may be taken or harmed in any manner.
5. You are required to submit a record of the nests and eggs destroyed and their disposition by **September 1, 2021**. You must also retain a copy for your records.
6. All authorized persons engaged in Canada goose nest and egg destruction must have a copy of this permit in their possession.
7. The property owner or occupant on whose premises Canada Goose nest and egg control activities are taking place must allow, at all reasonable times, including during actual operations, free and unrestricted access to any U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service special agent or refuge officer, or Illinois Conservation Police Officer on the premises where they are, or were conducting activities.
8. All applicable local laws pertaining to Canada goose nest and egg destruction must be followed.
9. Permittee is not an employee of the Department of Natural Resources.
10. Permittee is restricted to taking 7 Canada goose nests and all of the eggs in those nests in In aggregate on all lands under said agencies' jurisdiction.
