Subject: From Chief Safety Officer Amber Kenney: Coronavirus update

Dear colleagues,

Fermilab management continues to closely monitor Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19). Daily updates from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) as well as the Departments of State and Energy are reviewed for additional guidance.

COVID19 symptoms are flu-like and may include fever, cough and difficulty breathing. Do not report to work to if you have these symptoms to prevent the spread to your co-workers. If your symptoms do not resolve or worsen, you should seek medical attention.

Practice everyday preventive actions, including:

- staying home when sick,
- covering coughs and sneezes,
- frequent handwashing, and
- routine cleaning of frequently touched surfaces and objects.

Additionally, the U.S. State Department has restricted travel to China and has extended alerts for travel to Italy, Japan and South Korea. The lab has started an enhanced approval process for travel to these countries. Please contact the Travel Office for more details (travel.fnal.gov).
